It replaces the former Packeteer Specialist (Level 1) course and is intended for users who want to apply new PacketShaper features that deliver integrated visibility, control and compression capabilities in a single appliance. - > Classify traffic
- > Analyze your network, application and host performance

This course is intended for IT professionals requiring basic operational network management knowledge and skills; i.e., network/system administrators who are responsible for managing network application performance using the Blue Coat PacketShaper.
